


# Mission

## Community Needs

### Physical Needs

- The needs are generally a one-time occurrence involving one to four days of physical help.
- Emergencies such as those resulting from rain, wind, snow or ice. A clean up or repair effort is required.
- Non-emergency needs can be scheduled. These might be a fall clean up or a home repair project. An organization might have a new playground item to install or a repair of such an item.

### Spiritual Needs

The non-physical needs are also represented to ‘share the word of God’. Examples would be:

- How prayers are incorporated
- Spiritual needs are addressed &/or the need for a chaplin.
- “Sharing God’s Word and Developing Relationships”
- Homebound people
- People that just want to talk
- Hospital visits
