Kids in 1st-5th grades will have fun with our Circle of Friends

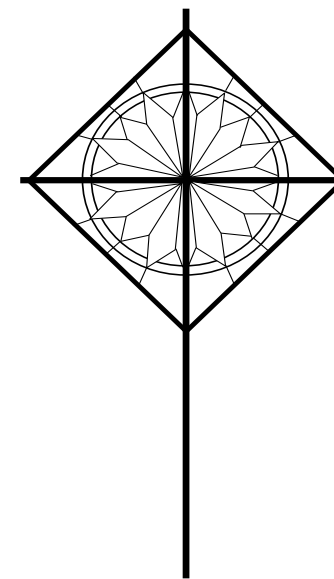
