May these words of my mouth and this **meditation** of my heart be pleasing in your sight, LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.

Some time ago, I fell behind in my Bible reading and meditation. Don't get me wrong, I read the word every day, but meditation as a ritual of reflection, maybe not every day; much as I would like to claim that. So as the time slipped away for both reading and meditation, I found myself looking for revelation from other students of the Word of God. Over the years I've collected several of these well-known Bible teachers. One year, one of them, in their teaching cautioned me not to rely on "their" Word from God only. Instead she encouraged me to create and carve out my own time to hear from God on my own. As God's children, we all have the same spirit revealing His heart to us, specific to our understanding.

An African story from my past shows my attitude clearly. I was 19 then and in my first job. I was an order typist for equipment parts for a mining company. The mining company mined several minerals like tin, copper, chromium, and gold. As I began my employment, I had a tour of their largest mine. We had to dress like a miner go down a mine shaft with a lamp on our head, they only took us about 500 meters below in this tin can of an elevator, only to arrive at a damp smelling level so a silent we were grateful when a generator started off in the distance around the bend, somewhere. The guide was brief and took us back up. 'yap nothing to see here', I thought. Back at on top, they gave us each; a rough rock that looks like unpolished granite with dirty yellowish orange-like specks on it; about the size of a small coffee mug, it was gold ore. I looked at it briefly, put it down, so did my new friend from the typing pool. We checked our equipment back in, had lunch and got back on the bus. I never thought about that tour until a few days later when our supervisor asked us what we felt about the gold room and if we were proud to hold pure African gold in our hands.

The naivety of 19-year-old me did not realize the worth of what I was holding in my hand enough to inquire how you get the valuable shiny gold bars out of that useless rock. I had no time for this old rock in the way I did not have time for real meditation of the word of God for a period in my life. You may feel that way at times. I think we all do at times. But honestly, when we do spend thoughtful time in the word, he is sure to carve out extra time for all other activities and reveal amazing gold nuggets into our lives. At first, meditation looks like a rigid requirement yet once you get started it is the most beautiful thing.

But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And on his law, he meditates day and night (Psalms 1:2).
